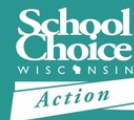

How to Become Eligible

Program eligibility is based on where the student lives and family income.

Student Residence

MPCP: City of Milwaukee

RPCP: Racine Unified School District (RUSD)

WPCP: Wisconsin, outside of Milwaukee and RUSD

SNSP: Wisconsin, no income eligibility required

Family Income

Family income must not exceed the income limits.

How to Apply

Online Application

Each year, parents must complete the [Online Parent Application](#) during an open application period.

Application Period

MPCP & RPCP: Month to month. Schools decide the application periods.

WPCP: February- April ONLY.

SNSP: Year round. July-June

Submit Documentation

Once application is complete provide requested documentation to the school(s) listed in your application before the application period ends.
