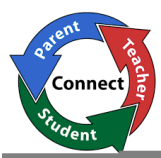
- January 18: God's Word and Works for Life (Eli Sievert)

And just like that, we are halfway through the school year and planning for 2025/2026 has already begun. After numerous meetings of your Board of Education and Church Council, several school initiatives are being implemented. To assist with rising operational expenses and to work toward getting in line with other federation schools, our tuition rates will be raised by \$500 for kindergarten to 8th grade. Early Childhood Ministry rates will not change. We are also streamlining our tuition structure by eliminating the “fellowship” and “non-member” categories and having one rate for all students.

Additionally, having been blessed with very generous donations in memory of beloved church member Dale Schreiber, we are able to offset the tuition increase for our current student families.

In addition, we will also be offering ten \$500 scholarships to encourage new families to become a part of our school ministry. This is where you can help get the word out about our school and the many opportunities we offer. Our current tuition assistance program also remains available to families on a case-by-case basis.

We will begin advertising through Mustang Matters in the weekly worship folder, in our Mustang Minute school newsletter, Facebook and our school website. We will also have new enrollment signs posted throughout our community which will offer “walk in Wednesdays”—an open house where our pastor and administrator will be offering guided tours of our school in action. Also remember, we are part of the Wisconsin Parental Choice Program and we would be happy to assist any family you know with determining their eligibility.
