## 2025 Guidelines

- Children may create their projects at home or use a project from art class at school.
   While we encourage parents to be involved in guiding their children, we ask that the projects be student-created. Please do not use kits, paint-by-number, or other premade items.
- All projects for grades 3-8 <u>will be counted as an Art Grade</u> and judged on the use of originality, composition, execution, and visual impact. Projects of students in PreK-2 are not graded/judged but students are invited to participate!
- All 2D (flat) projects on paper need to be matted (no frames) and cannot exceed 12 x
  18 inches including the mat. Construction paper matting is perfect. Stretched canvas
  or work on panels is acceptable and need not be mounted. 3D projects cannot exceed
  36 inches of total dimension. This means the height, width, and depth, when added
  together cannot be more than 36 inches. Laminating of projects is discouraged.

## **Categories**

- **Drawing:** 2D (flat), single medium: crayon, colored pencil, graphite, charcoal, oil pastel, sharpie, markers, chalk, soft pastel, ink, scratch art, etc.
- Painting: 2D (flat), single medium: watercolor, tempera, acrylic, finger painting
- Printmaking/Collage/Mosaic: Printmaking (a print or series of prints using paint, ink, etc. with an original design), collage (creating images using cut/torn paper and/or other materials), mosaic (creating images with an assemblage of small pieces of colored glass, stone, or other materials).
- **Sculpture:** 3D, wood, wire, paper mache, foil, clay, Model Magic, found materials. No ceramics are allowed at this time.
- **Mixed Media:** Using two or more mediums in addition to the surface on which the art is built (e.g. watercolor and ink; construction paper, charcoal, and Sharpie).
