Trinity Homeschool Co-op

Did you know that in Wisconsin, the number of families who homeschool their children has increased by over 40% since 2019? In 2019, homeschooled students made up 2.2% of Wisconsin's total K-12 population, but the most recent estimates show homeschoolers at 4.8% of the total. This provides an opportunity to look at a different way of delivering Christian education at Trinity. With the blessing of the Board of Ed and Church Council, Trinity is exploring the possibility of establishing an ELS/WELS Homeschool Cooperative (co-op) starting next school year. This effort is being led by Pastor and Sarah Hartwig. The main goal is to provide the opportunity for specialized education, group activities, and mutual support for Trinity's homeschool families and other homeschool families in the KML Federation.
